

The Ten Commandments Hike is an annual interfaith, cross-cultural event designed to introduce youth to a spectrum of religious traditions that value and teach principles from the Ten Commandments. The goal is for youth to gain greater understanding of the religious perspectives of different faiths, identify commonalities, and increase appreciation and tolerance of differing religious beliefs. At each house of worship visited, a religious leader or designated speaker will provide a 15-20 minute presentation, introducing youth to their faith and place of worship, and discussing two of the Ten Commandments.
